

ELISA:To detect hLIGHT by direct ELISA (using 100 μ L/well antibody solution) a concentration of at least 0.5 $\mu g/mL$ of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, allows the detection of 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hLIGHT. Sandwich:To detect hLIGHT by sandwich ELISA (using 100 μ L/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5 - 2.0 μg/mL of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with our Biotinylated Anti-Human LIGHTas a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hLIGHT.Western Blot:To detect hLIGHT by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1 - $0.2~\mu g/mL$. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hLIGHT is 1.5 - 3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-

reducing conditions.
