Rabbit anti Rat IgG1 IgG2a IgG2b IgG2c IgA IgM (heavy and light chains), conjugated with Horseradish peroxidase (orb22102)

Description

Horseradish peroxidase-conjugated IgG fraction of polyclonal rabbit antiserum to rat IgG, IgA and IgM, heavy and light chains. In enzyme-immunocytochemical and immunohistochemical staining for the detection of cytoplasmic Ig at the cellular and subcellular level by staining of appropriately treated cell and tissue substrates, and to demonstrate circulating antibodies in serodiagnostic microbiology and autoimmune diseases. The presence of activity to the common Ig/Fab subunit may result in the staining of immunoglobulins bound to Fcreceptors on non-lymphoid cells. Combinations of isotype-specific reagents or GARa/Ig(Fc)/PO should be used instead for this purpose. This immunoconjugate is not pre-diluted. The optimum working dilution of each conjugate should be established by titration before being used. Excess labelled antibody must be avoided because it may cause high unspecific background staining and interfere with the specific signal. Working dilutions for histochemical and cytochemical use are usually between 1:50 and 1:250; in ELISA and comparable non-precipitating antibody-binding assays between 1:500 and 1:10,000.

Preservatives Peroxidase-coupled purified hyperimmune rabbit IgG lyophilized from a solution

in phosphate buffered saline (PBS, pH 7.2). No preservative added, as it may

interfere with the antibody activity.

Form/Appearance Peroxidase-coupled purified hyperimmune rabbit IgG lyophilized from a solution

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Storage

The lyophilized conjugate is shipped at ambient temperature and may be stored at +4°C; prolonged storage at or below -20°C. Spun down to remove insoluble particles, divided into small aliquots, frozen and stored at or below -20°C. Prior to use, an aliquot is thawed slowly in the dark at ambient temperature, spun down again and used to prepare working dilutions by adding sterile phosphate buffered saline (PBS, pH 7.2). Repeated thawing and freezing should be avoided. Working dilutions should be stored at +4°C, not refrozen, and preferably used the same day. If a slight precipitation occurs upon storage, this should be removed by centrifugation. It will not affect the performance of the immunoconjugate.

Source Purified polyclonal rat IgG, and homogenous IgA and IgM isolated from rat

serum. Freund's complete adjuvant is used in the first step of the immunization

procedure.
