Rabbit anti Chicken ovalbumin, conjugated with FITC (orb22293)

Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody against Ovalbumin conjugated to FITC.
Species/Host	Rabbit
Conjugation	FITC
Preservatives	FITC-coupled purified hyperimmune rabbit IgG lyophilized from a solution in phosphate buffered saline (PBS, pH 7.2). No preservative added.
Form/Appearance	FITC-coupled purified hyperimmune rabbit IgG lyophilized from a solution in phosphate buffered saline (PBS, pH 7.2). No preservative added.
Storage	The lyophilized conjugate is shipped at ambient temperature and may be stored at +4°C; prolonged storage at or below -20°C. Prior to use, an aliquot is thawed slowly at ambient temperature, spun down again and used to prepare working dilutions by adding sterile phosphate buffered saline (PBS, pH 7.2). Repeated thawing and freezing should be avoided. Working dilutions should be stored at +4°C, not refrozen, and preferably used the same day. If a slight precipitation occurs upon storage, this should be removed by centrifugation. It will not affect the performance of the immunoconjugate.

Source	Highly purified egg albumin (MW 45,000) isolated from chicken egg whites. Freund's complete adjuvant is used in the first step of the immunization procedure.
