0.2 mg/ml in 1X PBS with 0.1 mg/ml rAlbumin (US

sourced) and 0.05% sodium azide

Storage

The CD45RB antibody (with azide) can be stored at 2-8°C. The azide-free format should be aliquoted and

stored at -20°C or colder.

Application notes

Due to variation in protocol and secondary antibody used, the CD45RB antibody may need to be titered for optimal performance.1. FFPE staining requires boiling tissue sections in 10mM citrate buffer, pH 6.0, for 10-20 min followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes.2. The prediluted format is supplied in a dropper bottle and is optimized for use in IHC. After epitope retrieval step (if required), drip mAb solution onto the tissue section and

incubate at RT for 30 min.
