Description	Rabbit polyclonal to ABCG1.ATP-binding cassette sub-family G member 1 (ABCG1) belongs to the ABC transporter superfamily,ABCG family. ABCG1 is a multi-pass membrane protein predominantly localized in the intracellularcomparents mainly associated with the endoplasmic reticulum (ER) and Golgi membranes. ABCG1may form heterodimers with several heterologous partners of the ABCG subfamily. ABCG1 is anactive component of the macrophage lipid export complex involved in macrophage lipid homeostasis.ABCG1 may also be involved in intracellular lipid transport processes.

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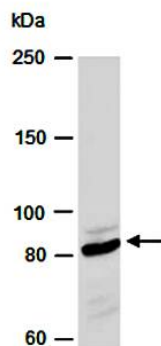
